

MEETING SUMMARY January 3, 2023

Date and Time: Tuesday, 3 January 2023 at 5:30pm Mountain time

The meeting was called to order at 5:36pm Mountain time.

Records of Past Meetings: The minutes of the 20 December meeting were approved without objection.

Category Rebuild: Caryn Ann reported that she is now working on the "records" portion of the category tree..

Site Statistics: Ed reported that traffic about doubled year-over-year, though some of that may be because this last year was an election year, and that there were again a significant number of files uploaded since his last report.

General LPedia: Caryn Ann reported that there is now a link to LPedia in the menu tree at the top of the main lp.org site (under "Libertarian Party" \rightarrow "Who We Are"), but she doesn't know when it was added.

Site Technical: There was mention of the fact that there is a new "Interface Administrator" permission that is required to be able to make certain kinds of modifications to the site, and brief discussion of who currently has other administrative permissions.

Disambiguation Articles: There was discussion of how to handle a case of two people with similar names – Steve Gordon vs. Steven Gordon.



Year Articles: James reported that he created an infobox template for these articles, which has space to feature a photo from that year along with a list of major news items from that year.

Storage Unit: Caryn Ann reported that she had been to the storage unit and will be working with a new volunteer who has been helpful before. She will be following up on an e-mail from someone in Pennsylvania who said he had a "treasure trove" of material in his basement.

Uploading Material Already Scanned: Sam said he expects to get the uploading of newsletters on which he has been working completed by the end of February.

Twitter: Lisa reported that our HPC-specific Twitter profile is up to 140 followers. She is selecting items from LPedia to share, and also is on the lookout for mentions of LPedia by others. There was discussion of making use of TweetDeck to allow other committee members to post things.

Alabama: Sam said he has gotten copies of minutes of the state Executive Committee and plans to upload them assuming the EC gives permission

New York: Andrew reported that somebody who was active in the 1970s sent him some photos, giving him his chance to see what the LP's office in Manhattan looked like.
