CONVENTION ACCOMMODATIONS

Rather than getting entangled in a lot of red tape, we have decided to let everyone who is attending the Conference make his or her own arrangements regarding accommodations.

We suggest that if you can afford it, you stay at the Radisson, the hotel at which the Conference sessions will be held; this will not only make it easiest for you to get back and forth to sessions, but also gives you the right to use the facilities of the Denver Playboy Club, located on the top floor of the Radisson. The Radisson is a good hotel, and not hyper-expensive. A postpaid reservation card is provided for you to use in making your reservations.

In case you don't want to stay at the Radisson, we have listed below three alternatives; you can write or call for reservation information.

Brown Palace -- 17th and Tremont, Denver 80202; Phone (303) 825-3111

"The Brown" is the place to stay in Denver, being very elegant and historical, and all that. They have a new wing and an old wing, and their rates range from \$23 upward for a single, \$28 upward for a double. About four blocks from the Radisson.

Mayflower Motel -- 1700 Grant, Denver 80203; Phone (303) 623-1226

A modest motel located just down the block from the Radisson. Singles run \$12.50, doubles \$14.50 to \$17.50, and if you go three to a room, it costs no more than a double.

YMCA -- 25 East 16th Avenue, Denver 80202; Phone (303) 244-4393

The "Y" rents rooms to both men and women, with singles running \$4.75 to \$7.25. Doubles run about \$9. Most rooms do not have a private bath. Located about four blocks from the Radisson.

If even the "Y" is a bit heavy for your pocketbook, we will try (no guarantees) to get you some kind of crash space. This will cost you \$2, and you'll have to bring a sleeping bag. We don't advise going this route, however, as we can't say where you'll wind up, and you'll have to get yourself back and forth.

If you want to share a room with someone, to minimize expenses, but don't know anyone who's coming, tell us when you're arriving, where you'd like to stay (first and second choices), and we'll send you the name of someone of the same sex who's arriving about the same time, and has similar accommodation preferences. The two of you can work things out from there; we'll send you each other's names.

Wherever you decide to stay, please tell us, by marking the enclosed Conference Registration Form. And make your reservations as early as possible; Colorade is crawling with tourists in June, and you may have problems if you wait until June.
