CONVENTION 1996!

The convention is coming up and you need to be there! This will be the most important convention the ALP has ever held. Why? Because this election is the most promising in the history of the ALP—our best opportunity to break through into the big time. We've been doing our homework, and it's time for the payoff.

ALP members have conducted five OPH operations (six by the time this reaches you). Thus far, 434 people have been surveyed. A whopping 138 (31%) score libertarian. That's the largest category—conservatives are next with 114 (26%). Obviously, the potential for support is out there. Because of our efforts, more people than ever will be involved with the ALP by election time, and even more will know we're alive and well and what we stand for!

The media knows we're alive and well too! We've been sending press releases to the local papers and news outlets in Montgomery after every OPH. They know we're growing and getting the word out. Moreover, the number of appearances on talk shows, news shows, and published work in local and national papers by ALP members are greater than ever before.

And we've got financial support coming in thanks to your generous response to the party's solicitation. We now have the resources to do many of the things that the major parties do such as enlisting the services of professional campaign consultants.

And we've begun to do just that. We're already benefiting from our relationship with the Monticello Group in Washington, D.C. We're also in touch with Aristotle in Atlanta, an organization that is used nationwide in professional campaigns. What this is doing for us is aiding in fund raising, and providing campaign materials such as manuals, voter demographics, and strategic advice. In short, we're professionalising.

We've got it all going except, well—now we need candidates. That's what this convention is all about—nominating candidates—and that's why you need to be there. At this point, the only people who have committed to seeking nominations are:

Mike Seibert—Supreme Court Charles Russell—U.S. Senate Mike Probst-Congress, 2nd District

That won't cut it! We've got the resources. We've got the energy. Now let's get the candidates. We owe it to the 31% of the population of our state that is on our side—the 31% that are libertarian. What's more, we've got to do our part to fulfill the national party's goal of running LP candidates for a majority of the seats in the House of Representatives. No third party has done this since the Socialists in the 1920s. The national party spent \$23,000 getting the ALP on the ballot. Let's do our part! We've got six other congressional seats to fill. Other offices are also open and waiting for us to contest them.

I hope you see how important your attendance is to the ALP, the national LP, and, above all, the folks who dream of self-government in our time. Make your plans to attend now. Costs have been cut in half to maximize attendance. This year's registration for the convention is only \$25. Your registration includes all events and a gourmet lunch buffet. Those who attended last year can attest to how good the food is. The convention is being held at the River Front Inn in Montgomery which, in addition to excellent food, has wonderful accommodations for those who wish to stay over and is located within walking distance of the Alabama River and Montgomery's new scenic/historic river walk. The convention is being held Saturday, April 27th. We look forward to seeing you there.

Friday Evening Gathering Of Eagles


