COME TO BIRMINGHAMand enjoy the excitement of mingling with others who are fired up for liberty! This will be the last Alabama LP convention before the Big-Brother year of 1984. Let's make this the beginning of a renewed battle to put Big Brother in his place and to proclaim, once and for all, the necessity and the rightness of individual freedom.

THE PLACE is the Quality Inn South on Oxmoor Road in Homewood. From north or south come into Birmingham on I-65 and get off on the Oxmoor exit. The Quality Inn (formerly the Rodeway Inn) is right next to the Interstate, so you can't miss it.

THE CONVENTION begins with a business session from 1 to 5 p.m. Several important decisions will be made here. We will elect party officers for the coming year. We will nominate candidates for this fall's legislative races which have been called due to redistricting. We will choose delegates (8 of them) to the national LP convention in New York, where the 1984 Libertarian presidential candidate will be chosen. Voting members of the Alabama LP are particularly urged to attend the business session. There is no charge for this portion of the convention.

THE EVENING PROGRAM begins at 6:30 p.m. There will be hors d'oeuvres and a cash bar. Speakers will include 1982 LP gubernatorial candidate Henri Klingler and Dianne Pilcher, our Region 19 (Alabama-Georgia-Florida) representative to the LP national committee. We also plan to show the film, "The Incredible Bread Machine," and we are at this writing attempting to firm up another libertarian speaker, from the faculty of one of our Alabama universities. (State Chair Steve Smith plans to call as many of you as possible just prior to the convention, and will let you know at that time who this speaker will be.) Cost for the evening program is just \$10 per person.

SEND IN your registration form today. Or bring it with you the day of the convention (Pre-registration will be most helpful to us, however). We look forward to seeing you in Birmingham on June 11!
