

MEETING SUMMARY March 1, 2022

Date and Time: Tuesday 1 March 2022 at 5:30pm Mountain time

The meeting was called to order at 5:36pm Mountain time.

Records of Past Meetings: The minutes of the 21 February meeting were approved without objection.

Records Archive Update: Caryn Ann reported that she had some items from Louisiana given to her in Florida that she will be scanning and sending back. There is no update yet on the scanning job being done in New Mexico.

Nolan Collection: Caryn Ann reported that she heard from the Library of Congress that they received the material, but with no detail about how much material there is or whether it includes the scan that Buchman said he prepared for them.

Templates: Andrew said that the templates mentioned in the agenda have been created.

Categories: Caryn Ann said she is continuing to go over the categories again. There was discussion of whether it makes sense to have categories or lists of Libertarians elected in a given year, vs. serving in public office during a given year. Joe said this was a useful category and should be titled differently, but it could be considered to be a kind of election data. It was agreed that such lists should be categorized, along with other information about elections, in the "event" portion of the category tree. Joe noted however that winners of elections are a subset of candidates in elections, and that we currently consider candidates to be part of the "people" portion of the tree.



Site Statistics: Ed said that the level of traffic has been stable.

Site Technical: It was noted that MyWikis had an outage for which they apologized, but which apparently did not last long enough for any of us to notice.

New York: Andrew reported that he spoke by phone with Gary Greenberg, who was the 3rd and 9th state chair and who provided material that Andrew is scanning; this includes some newsletters from before the LP was formed. He also did a 2.5 hour interview with John Caulfield, who attended the first meeting of the state party. He is also going to try to arrange an interview with Ray Strong, who was the 2nd state chair.

Colorado: Caryn Ann reported that their state HPC will be having its first meeting tomorrow. She is currently a member because she is the Secretary of the state party, but she is not running for re-election so may not continue on the committee.

National Convention: Caryn Ann reported that she wrote to Jim Turney saying we want a table with electricity. She also volunteered to do a breakout session on the Statement of Principles.
