12 LADY GODIVA'S WILL RIDE AGAIN . . . drawing attention to the LP's National Tax Protest Day in cities throughout the country. Thanks to the tremendous effort of Ed Jowett (National Coordinator) and many state and local activists, there will be at least 200 protests nationwide--increasing the potential for significant media coverage.

For information regarding Tax Day Protests in your locale try contacting your State Chair. If nothing exists in your area--and you would like to do something on the 15th--you might consider making copies of the enclosed flyer and distribute them locally. (Passing them out at the main Post Office between 8 p.m. and midnight on the 15th could catch a lot of people with taxes weighing heavily on their minds.)

ANOTHER 25,000 SOCIAL INSECURITY CARDS DISTRIBUTED . . . some of which are finding their way into places where the impact can be considerable. For example, 75 recently sent to Kevin E. Monohan of Prospect, Oregon, in response to the following letter:

"Dear Sirs: I am an eighth grader and this year in class we are asked to join the Social Security system. I would like for you to send me and my family ten of your Social Insecurity cards so I can help to educate the other students in my class."

LP-SPONSORED BALLOT ACCESS LEGISLATION PASSES IN NEW MEXICO . . . largely as a result of the hard work of State Chair Christa Bolden and others who lobbied for this measure which lowered petition requirements from 3% to .5% of registered voters to get on the ballot, and from 15% to 5% to remain on the ballot once there.
