Severe conflicts with my schedule (campaign and job) caused delays in completing treasury work this quarter. Income from the July fundraiser totaling \$130 (received 7/7) not yet counted toward the total. Richard

Cooper has confirmed LPNY must begin filing reports to BOE, but LPNY should decide whether the organization continues under the Free Libertarian Party name, or formally change the corporate name to LPNY for filing purposes. Global Card Service received \$1,495 payment from LPNY in April, but our contract to them was submitted only this week, and Prime Pay is being completed this weekend, using LPNY's EIN (#13-3088211). As of next week, LPNY can proceed to 1) begin use of merchant credit card account, and 2) participate in Prime Pay, a direct deposit system for UMP checks. When W. Boyce's \$1,000 credit card contribution, LP UMP July check of roughly \$1,600, and new fundraiser contributions are added, the actual balance should be at about \$17,400.
