## Minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention of the Libertarian Party of New York held on Saturday April 21, 2012 at the Ukrainian East Village Restaurant, 140 Second Avenue, New York, New York

[Note: last year's minutes incorrectly identified the 2011 Annual Convention as the 40<sup>th</sup>; the LPNY was organized on April 22, 1972; the first Annual Convention was held on March 31, 1973.]

The Convention was called to order by Chair Mark Axinn at 11:05.

New members were granted permission to vote without objection.

Chair Mark Axinn relinquished the chair to Vice-Chair Audrey Capozzi without objection in order to run for the position of Party Chair.

Mark Axinn was elected Chair by show of cards, running unopposed.

Chair Mark Axinn returned to the chair.

Audrey Capozzi and Christian Padgett were elected Vice-Chairs by show of cards, running unopposed as a pair.

Blay Tarnoff was elected Secretary by show of cards, running unopposed.

Gary Triestman was elected Treasurer by show of cards, running unopposed.

## Mark Glogowski, Adam Martin, Christopher Garvey, Michael Houze, and Craig Pratka were elected State Committee Members At Large by ballot.

Christopher Edes and Rob Robinson were nominated for endorsement for the office of U.S.

Senate; Rob Robinson was nominated in absentia. Christopher Edes was endorsed for the office of U.S. Senate by two thirds majority show of cards.

## Motion by Bruce Martin to inform Rob Robinson that the Convention of the Libertarian Party of New York encourages him to run for another public office passed by show of cards.

Bylaws amendment #1: In Article VI, section A, add "The Immediate Past Chair is the person, if any, who ceased to be the Chairperson at the end of the last Annual Convention." was debated and passed by two thirds majority show of cards.

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Bylaws amendment #2:
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In Article VI, section F, strike out "except that the State Chairperson shall vote only to resolve a tie" and insert "The presiding officer at any Convention or meeting of the State Committee may vote only when the vote is by ballot or his vote would affect the result."

was debated and passed by two thirds majority show of cards.

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Bylaws amendment #3:
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In Article V, section F, strike out "officers and Committee persons-at-large" and insert "officers, Committee persons-atlarge and delegates" and strike out "of" before "good standing" and insert "in". was debated and passed by two thirds majority show of cards.

Bylaws amendment #4:

In Article III, section A, subsection 2, last sentence, insert "remove or" before "replace" and insert "County" before "Chairperson" and in the previous sentence, capitalize the first letter in "county". was debated and passed by two thirds majority show of cards.

Bylaws amendment #5:

Strike out "State Chairperson" and insert "Chair" wherever the term appears, strike out "Chairperson" and insert "Chair" wherever the term appears, strike out "State Vice-Chairperson" and insert "Vice-Chair" wherever the term appears, strike out "Vice-Chairperson" and insert "Vice-Chair" wherever the term appears, strike out "State Committee persons-at-Large" and insert "Members At Large" wherever the term appears, and strike out "Committee persons-at-Large" and insert "Members At Large" wherever the term appears. was debated and passed by two thirds majority show of cards.

Bylaws amendment #6:

In Article XII, section F, subsection 1, strike out "forty-five (45)" and insert "fifty (50)". was debated and passed by two thirds majority show of cards.

The Convention was adjourned at 12:20.
