To keep government small and accountable. What is your approach to governing growth?

What are your top priorities and how will they be addressed?

High cost of living

What are the biggest opportunities and good things happening in Castle Rock now?

Castle Rock's people and environment are like heaven on earth - we need more freedom and less government.

Crime is also a regional issue impacting the Denver metro area - What is Castle Rock doing right to address the issues? Where can Cas improve?

Focus on actual crimes that harm people and property and lay off victimless crimes.

Castle Rock asked voters to approve four tax measures in 2021 - The measures were aimed at improving public safety and addressing traffic concerns. As the population grows - What do you think Castle Rock should be doing to be proactive and stay on top of roads and infrastructure and the growing need for more firemen, officers and stations?

I opposed those taxes. I dispute the need for more of the government enforcement arm.
