## RULE 8: ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND NATIONAL COMMITTEE

Problem: Approval voting with a majority threshold increases the likelihood of distorted representation of delegates in elections for National Committee members at-large and the Judicial Committee. Although proportional representation ranked choice voting would facilitate a closer fit between delegate preferences and electoral outcomes, our Party's rules and infrastructure don't currently accommodate that method.

Solution: Replace approval voting with a majority threshold with a semi-proportional electoral method outlined in our parliamentary authority called "cumulative voting."

Benefits: Implements a more representative electoral method to populate our Party's elected committees.
