LIBERTARIANS LEAD THE WAY WITH LV ANTI - INCOME TAX ACTIVITY

NO OBJECTION TO ABUSIVE TAX OR IRS VOICED BY REPUBLICAN OR DEMOCRATIC PARTIES

The Income Tax, with its merry band of henchmen: the IRS, those lawless bureaucrats masking as collection agents, will certainly see some activity from the Libertarians this April. Because the other two parties sit by the wayside, as usually timid, the status quo of our country's counter-productive, unconstitutional and generally loathsome income tax will remain protected. The Libertarian Party of Clark County has already begun its assault on the tax and its most avid supporters: the spineless R's & D's, and plans to continue the fearless assault right on up to the tax filing deadline.

In case you missed it, on March 22, 1988 Vice-Presidential LP candidate. Andre' Marrou filled the K-DWN airwaves with a powerful delivery of the Libertarian message. The talk-show was precluded by two days of commercials denouncing the IRS while advertising the event. This purchase, made possible by your fund-raising efforts, made the station's management very receptable to the idea of an LP guest. Mr. Marrou got very positive response, including 100% unanimous agreement with our stand on the income tax. He was enthusiastically invited back in June. "Free Kentucky," newsletter of LP-Kentucky, has refloated a Mitch Wayne idea that the party's nomination for the U. S. Presidential race should be sold, and not simply voted on. To start a campaign warchest and begin, collecting money for TV exposure, Wayne suggests that candidates put up \$2,000, that nominators put up \$1,000, seconders: \$500, with \$100 expected from rank and file members who want to vote for a candidate, with the eventual winner taking the whole pot to get started on.

Powerful political math is offered by Rich Kleinow in "Minnesota Libertarian:" Suppose the conservative estimate of 100 libertarians in each state. If each one signed up just one new member per year, there would be 40,960,000



LEGISLATIVE BODYSNATCHERS

Does the state have the right to give the gift of life? It seems like some of the folks in Carson City think so. On April 3rd, the Nevada Assembly passed AB 226 by a 26 - 15 margin. This is a bill that would permit a coroner to donate body parts of a deceased individual without prior approval from the deceased or his heirs. Under this legislation, anatomical "gifts" would not be permitted if the deceased opposed the donation before death, or if heirs disapproved.

Let's consider a situation where a deceased individual had not gone out of their way to make it perfectly clear that he or she did not wish to be disected after death? What about someone who might object to this anatomical gift procedure on the grounds of theological or philosophical conviction? Who would defend his preferences? Do his individual

rights cease to exist upon the conclusion of his physical life? Are those individual rights to be naturalized automatically to the state upon his demise?

This sounds like some interesting stuff for the U.S. Supreme court to thrash about, but not the Nevada Legislature. It is now going to the Senate for a vote. If you would like to have a say on this issue while you are still breathing, give your Senator a call at 1-800-
