- 3) ROLL BACK RENTS


Dr. Walter Block is running for the New York State Assembly in the 65th A.D. The incumbent in the 65th A.D., Andrew Stein, not only is a strong adherent of rent control, but favors its extension to commercial, industrial and hotel structures as well. He would prohibit the demolition of unprofitable but structurally sound buildings. He advocates the city take over buildings with vacant apartments.
