Libertarian National Committee Executive Committee. Regular Meeting, Wednesday, September 6, 1995. [Draft.]

A regular meeting of the Executive Committee of the Libertarian National Committee was held on Wednesday, September 6, 1995, at 8:30 p.m. Eastern Daylight Saving Time, by telephone conference call.

Three of the five voting members were present at the beginning of the meeting:

- the chair, Steve Dasbach,
- the vice chair, Karen Allard, and
- the secretary, John D. Famularo.

The treasurer, Hugh A. Butler, and the LNC representative, Sharon Ayres was absent. Non-voting observers were also present.

The national director, Perry Willis, reported that another \$10,300 had been raised in the Major Donor Program. Karen Allard moved to authorize \$20,000 from the Major Donor Program to start the petition drive for ballot access in West Virginia, subject to verification by Steve Dasbach and Perry Willis that the funds were available. The motion passed.

The director of communications, Bill Winter, described activity in the Iowa LP, including plans for a state convention in January.

Steve Dasbach noted that the Governor of Ohio had signed into law a bill allowing parties to substitute the name of a Presidential candidate and that this will allow an Ohio petition drive to start earlier.

The Campaign area manager, Ron Crickenberger, said he had received some written requests from candidates for campaign funding from the party.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m. EDT.
