The Libertarian Party of NY held annual convention on April 26, 2008 at the Reception House in Flushing Queens.

Former Senator Mike Gravel and former Congressman Bob Barr addressed the gathering as Libertarian Presidential hopefuls. Convention goers were afforded the opportunity to ask questions of Senator Gravel and Congressman Barr

New York's own Alden Link and John Finan, as well as Mike Jingozian and Wayne Root also addressed the body as Presidential hopefuls. Ray Carr, Dr. Mary Ruwart's husband spoke, as well as representatives from the Christine Smith and Steve Kubby campaigns.

Eric Sundwall of Columbia County NY was elected Chair. Mark Axxin of Manhattan and Chris Edes of Rochester were elected as Vice-Chairs. Gary Popkin and Joseph Dobrian were re-elected as Treasurer and Secretary.

Estelle Edwards, Richard Cooper, M Carling, Michael Reid and Audrey Capozzi were elected At-Large Representatives.

Bylaws provisions were passed, making renewals less problematic based on the calendar year. Dr. Mindy Thompson Fullilove of the Columbia School of Public Health and the Root Shock Institute (<u>www.rootshock.org</u>) to spoke about her book, "Root Shock: How Tearing Up City Neighborhoods Hurts America".

LIBERTARIANS NOMINATE BOB BARR FOR '08

This past Memorial Day weekend the Libertarian Party of the United States nominated Bob Barr and Wayne Root for President and Vice-President in Denver Colorado. National Libertarian delegates selected Barr on the sixth round of voting at an old fashioned American political convention, entirely unfunded by taxpayers.

Barr, a former Congressman from Georgia, apologized to Libertarians for voting for the Patriot Act and provisions of the Defense of Marriage Act. Citing the unprecedented growth of government and loss of basic civil rights, Barr outlined a campaign that would focus on withdrawal from Iraq, fiscal restraint and a return to the real role of the Constitution. Barr sits on the board of the NRA.
