

Rationale: While it can be inferred from the plank, it is becoming more common for those not holding consistent Libertarian positions to argue that we only advocate for decriminalization or legalization of mere possession of drugs, rather than our position that drugs should be treated as any other market item and the drug war FULLY ended.

**Proposal:**

Victimless Crimes

Criminal and civil laws should be limited to violations of the rights of others through fraud, force, or deliberate and credible threats of imminent force. We therefore reject all laws that create "crimes" without victims, for voluntary and consensual activities such as, but not limited to, the [manufacture, sale, possession, and](#) use of drugs for medicinal or recreational purposes, [prostitution](#); and gambling. We also reject government placing itself as a proxy victim of alleged "crimes."

**Motion:**

*Add the words "manufacture, sale, possession, and" prior to the phrase "use of drugs" and replace the following commas with semi-colons in the Victimless Crimes plank.*
