As amended on 4/2:

4.0 Omissions

Our silence about any other government law, regulation, ordinance, directive, edict, control, regulatory agency, activity, or machination, including the necessity of any particular governmental system, should not be construed to imply approval.

Additional Motion on 4.0 The original motion as reference:

4.0 Omissions

Our silence about any other particular government law, regulation, ordinance, directive, edict, control, regulatory agency, activity, or machination, including the existence of any particular governmental system, should not be construed to imply approval.

**On these Omissions proposals, please be advised that the chair is likely to exercise their right to debate, but will not vote unless vote needed to cause or break a tie.

Motion to amend previously adopted Space Exploration plank (McHoes)

Add to the end of the newly passed proposal to add 1.10 Space Exploration

This was not heard at the 4/2 meeting

We oppose all government restrictions upon voluntary, peaceful use of outer space. We oppose all government attempts to make outer space a personal club for the privileged only nations, and openly call upon all governments to make outer space free for peoples of all nations to explore space at their own expense and leisure and aim to keep its various wonders free from tribalism, nationalism, and other forms of human-limiting discriminating factors and confine those said factors to Terra-Firma (Earth) alone.

Procedure Notes

**First, a Motion to Amend Something Previously Adopted needs to pass by a simple majority (see RONR 305-310), and if so, handled like any other main motion.

Add New Plank regarding corporations

Current language (subject to refinement prior to meeting) is:

Corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations neither gain, nor lose any right they had previous to incorporation and are liable for their acts of willful negligence and fraud.

Procedure Note

Name new plank on corporations if new plank passes

Motion(s) Summary

-The Chair opens discussion on the primary additional language to amend 4.0, as amended previously Fast moved a substitute proposal to read:

Our silence about any other particular government law, regulation, ordinance, directive, edict, control, regulatory agency, activity, or machination, or even the existence of government itself, should not be construed to imply approval.

Perry moved for time limits on the agenda,

The Chair rules motion [OOO] citing RONR, 11th Ed, pg 500

Perry appeals ruling of the Chair

Ruling of the Chair <u>SUSTAINED 6-6-2</u> at 7pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 2</u>), return to the Fast motion

Fast moved to amend "existence" to "necessity", <approved without objection>

Fast amended substitute motion <u>FAILS 6-8</u> at 7:48 pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 3</u>), return to the main motion

Additional language to amend 4.0 <u>PASS 12-2</u> at 7:53pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 4</u>) move to space plank motion

The proposed 4.0 amended text is adopted and will be assigned ballot PC2020-PC#18, current text:

Our silence about any other government law, regulation, ordinance, directive, edict, control, regulatory agency, activity, or machination, including the necessity of any particular governmental system, should not be construed to imply approval.

-The Chair now opens discussion on the motion to amend previously adopted Space Exploration plank Fulner moves to postpone until next meeting

Fulner motion <u>FAILS 3-11</u> at 8:04pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 5</u>)

Main motion <u>FAILS 0-12-1</u> at 8:08pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 6</u>)

-The Chair now opens discussion on the corporations proposal

Different viewpoints were expressed and a few amendments arose from discussion, none of which passed *During this motion, Ebke announces departure at 8:18 in chat

Cholko moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

We believe that corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations must be liable for their acts of willful negligence and fraud.

Fast moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

We believe that corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations must be liable for their acts of willful negligence and fraud, should that occur.

Fast amendment FAILS 3-11 at 8:32pm (see vote Tally Ballot 7), return to Cholko amendment

Perry moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

We believe that corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Members and shareholders of corporations must be liable for acts of willful negligence and fraud.

Perry amendment <u>FAILS 1-8-5</u> at 8:47pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 8</u>), return to Cholko amendment

^{*}Longstreth sat in place for the remainder of the meeting, quorum is not changed and remains at 15/8/10

Fast moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

We believe that corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations must be liable for their acts of willful negligence and fraud. We reject government charters of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state. The Chair rules this amendment [OOO] because it goes beyond the scope of the first level amendment. The Chair states when Fast can move this language and will be first inline to speak when the Cholko amendment is disposed of

Taylor moved to strike "their", the new language, if adopted would read:

We believe that corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations must be liable <u>for acts</u> of willful negligence and fraud.

Taylor amendment <u>FAILS 6-7-1</u> at 8:57pm(see vote Tally <u>Ballot 9</u>), return to Cholko amendment Cholko amendment <u>FAILS 5-7-2</u> at 8:58pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 10</u>), return to main motion Main motion currently:

Corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinctly from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations neither gain, nor lose any right they had previous to incorporation and are liable for their acts of willful negligence and fraud.

The Chair called for orders of the day, to move to item 7, closing announcements
