The Education Reform Movement is a fraud devised to extract more money from the taxpayers.

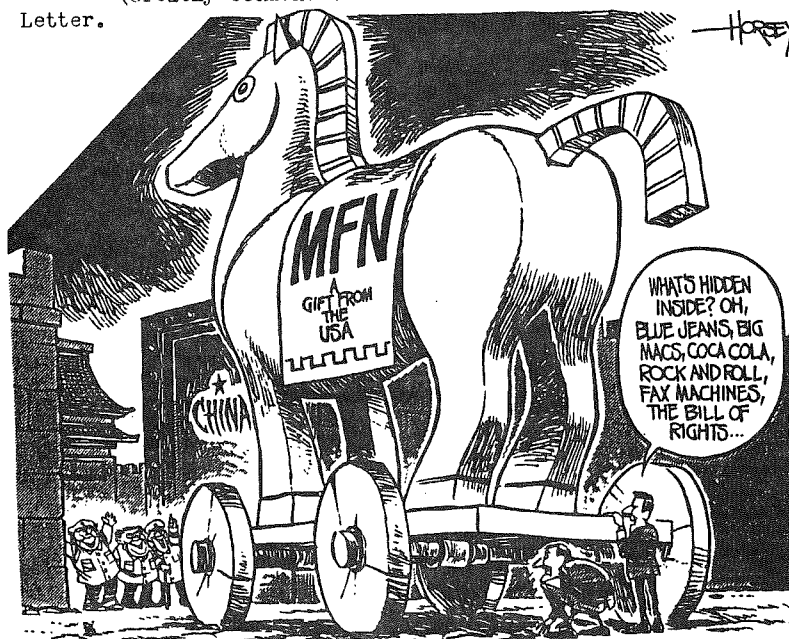
We will also see more teenage depression, suicide and mental problems due to heavier doses of death education, values clarification, and New Age pagan mysticism.

Carmen B., mayor of Isle of Palms: Commodore Sir Peter Parker Highest Casualties, for keeping residents from rescuing their property after Hurricane Hugo. (Sir P P lost the attempt to invade Charleston by sea with loss of 2 entire bridges on his ship except himself.)

Should School Athletes be Tested for Drugs

New York City Police Department officials recently announced that all of the city's police personnel, from those in patrol to Commissioner Benjamin Ward, will be subject to periodic random testing for drug use. The New York City Police Department, with over 26,000 officers, is the largest department to adopt this policy. Detroit, Miami and Honolulu already have random drug testing for police officers.

Chicago Police Supt. LeRoy Martin also came out recently in support of random drug testing of all police officers. Presently Chicago police officers are tested at two levels, that is, during pre-employment physical examinations and physicals for promotion. Supt. Martin said 68 police officers currently are under house arrest for drug use.

John Dineen, president of the Chicago chapter of the Fraternal Order of Police, said he supports Supt. Martin's proposal; the president of the FOP, which represents Chicago's 10,000 police officers, observed: "If they want drug testing, that's fine with us. Drugs shouldn't be taken by anyone, especially police officers."

Some unions representing suburban Illinois police and fire personnel, however, have indicated a hesitancy to back random drug testing. But, according to Ted Gorski, a veteran law enforcement officer for a suburban Illinois police department, "If the unions won't support drug testing, they're making a big mistake. We recently had 180 applicants for police positions in our department; only 6 qualified. Most of the applicants failed because they had a history of drug use or else they couldn't pass the drug test. How can police officers enforce the laws against drugs when they're using drugs themselves?"

Just recently the Governor of Illinois signed into law a \$44.3 million drug package that makes it a felony to distribute anabolic steroids and requires schools to educate children about the harmful effects of muscle-building drugs. "Steroid use has no legitimate purpose in athletics," said the Governor. "We want the cheating and the drugs out of sports."

According to Dr. Wayne Goldstein, who works at Parkside Sports Medicine Center at Lutheran General Hospital in Park Ridge, Ill., when high school athletes come into his office with biceps bulging out of once-scrawny arms, he immediately knows they have been using steroids. "Look at their muscle definition and you can tell right away," he says.

Dr. Robert Patek, who is Dr. Goldstein's colleague at the center, observes: "All... I want to do is get out the message that steroid users are taking a terrible risk with their health. What really bothers me is the young players who use muscle-bound weight lifters and football players as role models. When the effects of what they're doing to their bodies begin to show up in a few years, they'll kick themselves. By then, it might be too late."

In this connection, the school board of Indianola Academy in Indianola, Mississippi, has passed a regulation requiring that every student in grades 7 through 12, every teacher and the 24 directors of the all-white private school submit urine samples on demand.

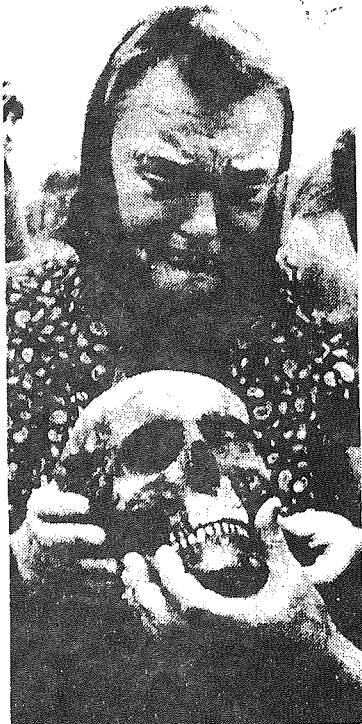
According to school policy, a positive test for drugs or alcohol would result in mandatory counseling, while a second positive test would result in suspension from extracurricular activities. If students or teachers refuse to submit to drug tests on request, they will be dismissed.

The school board of Homewood-Flossmoor High School in Illinois also has taken a remarkably tough stand on drug use by students. The school board has proposed that school athletes be tested for drugs and steroids.

According to Dan Lowy, a former athletic director and coach and a businessman in Park Ridge, Ill., "I fully support schools that warn and test the school athletes about drugs, because drugs can cause great physical and psychological harm. The coaches who distribute steroids, and the kids who take them, should be banned from school athletics."

Prospect, Ill., says: "If students and teachers don't have anything to hide, they should be willing to take the drug tests. How can teachers teach good morals to the kids if they're using drugs themselves? If we test the student athletes, we can find out which ones are using drugs and save them before it's too late."

Should school athletes be tested for drugs?

The drug testing of high school and college athletes would be a step in the right direction. The drug testing proposal must be put in the proper social context.

According to the National Institute on Drug Abuse, 70 million Americans older than 12 have used an illegal drug at least once in their lives. Thirty-seven million, approximately one in 5, have used drugs during the past year. At least one out of 8 — that is, 23 million people — have consumed an illicit drug during the past month.

Americans consume more than 50 percent of the world's entire supply of drugs. Moreover, an estimated 25 percent of all workers in the United States use dangerous drugs while at work.

Man is by nature a social animal; we need other human beings, and they need us. From these elementary truths, we can understand that we possess social and moral obligations, obligations that sometimes require us to subordinate our private, selfish interests and pursuits for the sake of the common good. In the case of drug testing, we must sacrifice a little bit of freedom for the sake of the moral well-being of society. This would be a valuable lesson for our young people to learn.

Competition would help improve cable services

It is clear from recent news reports that many local residents are dissatisfied with cable TV service. There are complaints of poor picture quality as well as poor scrambling of pay channels, surprising unsuspecting minors with glimpses of R-rated movies.

These problems are a product of the government-imposed franchise system. Local governments have imposed this monopoly and have outlawed freedom of competition. Without freedom of competition, there is no way to know whether cable TV fees are too high. Since consumers can't shop around, cable TV companies have little incentive to provide good quality services at reasonable rates.

In Henderson, Tenn., residents can choose between two cable TV companies. As a result, they have excellent service for as little as \$9 per month. There are even cities that have competing electric companies, and the consumers love it. Rates are lower, and service is better.

One thing is certain: If Columbia-area residents had the freedom to choose, most of the problems with cable TV service would vanish overnight. Why can't local governments realize that citizens are able to make intelligent decisions and don't need the government to tell them which services to use?

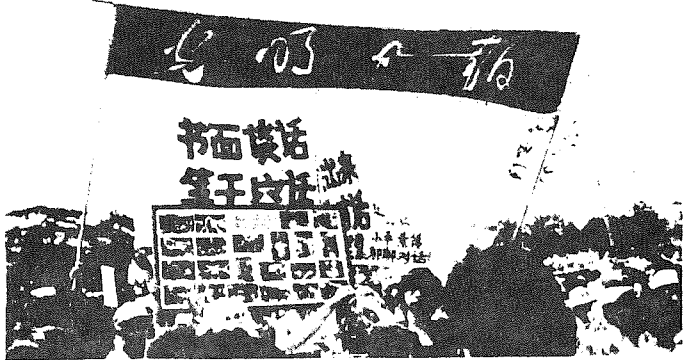
Zhang Jingsheng: aged 35, he was sentenced to 13 years' imprisonment in December 1989 for "counter-revolutionary" crimes during the pro-democracy demonstrations earlier in 1989. The sentence was handed down by the People's Intermediate Court of Changsha (the capital of Hunan Province).

Zhang Jingsheng was convicted on charges of making a speech at Hunan University in favour of "democracy" and "freedom"; involvement in the illegal Autonomous Federation of Workers; inciting workers to strike and students to boycott their classes; and writing an anti-government pamphlet. Autonomous federations of workers and students were formed in various Chinese cities in May 1989 and were banned by the government after martial law was imposed in Beijing on 20 May.

AI previously adopted Zhang Jingsheng as a prisoner of conscience while he was serving an earlier prison sentence for "counter-revolutionary propagan-

da". In April 1981 while working at a Changsha machine factory he was arrested during a crackdown on pro-democracy activists. He was then editor of an unofficial journal, *The Republican* (*Gonghebao*), created during an earlier "democracy movement" begun in 1978. The movement followed a relaxation in official policy which encouraged people to express opinions or grievances about miscarriages of justice. A number of prisoners arrested at that time are still imprisoned, most notably Wei Jingsheng, Xu Wenli and Wang Xizhe.

Toward Enlightenment

In 1962, James Meredith, the black who integrated Ole Miss, was blasted in the chest by a shotgun while tramping down a Mississippi highway in his never-ending pursuit of Negro interests. (Walter Cronkite pronounced him dead on national television.) Last year, Meredith joined the staff of Sen. Jesse Helms (R-NC) and sidled around the country tweaking some of the self-serving attitudes held by most blacks.

On March 28, he explained to an audience at Boston's Suffolk University that black slavery was "no big deal," especially when all the other races had had experiences with the "peculiar institution." The present "breakdown of civilization" is what should be worrying blacks, the Helmsman added.

Meredith said that no documentation exists showing that whites ever directly captured blacks for slavery. The method was invariably to purchase blacks from other blacks. Swallowing hard, Meredith then told his Kennedy-land crowd that the "decision" of blacks to sell fellow blacks to whites was a "wise one," as it brought the race into closer contact with "the reality of the human experience at the time."

The issue of American divestiture in South Africa was cooked up by the Democratic Party in late 1984, recalled Meredith, to combat the popularity of newly reelected Ronald Reagan, while diverting attention from the graver problems facing American blacks -- problems which liberalism was powerless to solve. No African -- "except those that go to Harvard" -- ever really wanted divestiture, he contended.

When at last Meredith came to his main point, he sounded like Louis Farrakhan with a twist. America's liberal elite, he said, most of them white -- he singled out Ted Kennedy by name -- had conspired to oppress black people. These days, Meredith regretted to say, every Negro and his brother are blaming their plight on everybody but themselves. If it weren't for slavery, they believe, they'd be out hustling like a bunch of Hong Kong Chinese.

Gay minister conducts safer sex survey

CHARLESTON, S.C. — After conducting his own survey, a gay minister here recently found that danger of HIV transmission at interstate highway rest areas and adult bookstores has reached crisis proportions.

According to *The News*, a gay newspaper in Atlanta, Rev. George Exoo spent five months interviewing men at local rest areas and bookstores. Exoo said he encountered ignorance of and resistance to safe sex. "Only one person [knew] what nonoxynol-9 is, and he refuses to use condoms," said Exoo. "In fact, rest area regulars tend to regard the use of condoms as an admission of AIDS and the absence of them as a sign of safety."

Exoo also reported that 80 percent of the men that cruise rest areas identify themselves as "bisexual" or "straight," that almost all the men interviewed were in long-term relationships with women, and that none of those women had knowledge of their partners' cruising activities.

White supremacists arrested

SEATTLE — Two white supremacists, who government agents say were planning to bomb businesses owned by Korean people, a synagogue, and bars with largely Black and/or gay clientele, were arrested here May 12. Both men live in Idaho and a third man was arrested in that state for his part in the plan, according to the *New York Times*.

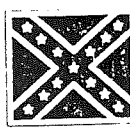

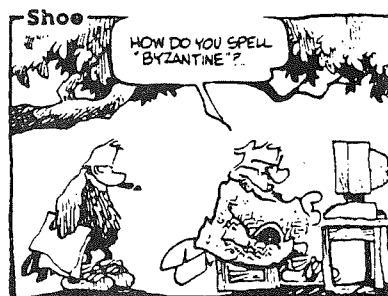

WHERE HAVE ALL THE FLOWERS GONE ?

I know, that as I keep dinging on the empty heads of the educrats, many will get tired of it. But teaching kids to cheat on tests is one of the worst disgraces - and you see the movie, "Stand and Deliver"?

And dumbing down, like the welfare system, has as its result, an increase in crime, a way of promoting totalitarianism. Look at welfare: to get help when unemployed and overtaxed, the father has to desert his wife & kids. The kids who grow up this way, grow up with more problems. The automatic promotion in school system, to pacify the social integrationists, discouraged children from learning. Kids can get to high school now without learning 1st & 2nd reading & arithmetic.

And like the welfarist system, the humanistic school system (with its discrimination against religious knowledge & beliefs), seeks to corrupt & send kids into an immoral life.

And even NEA Today agrees with me on the burnouts in

the line, "what's good for burnouts is Good for America," comes from Jocks and Burnouts, Penelope Eckert's new study of social class in a suburban Detroit high school.

Eckert's burnouts are working class white kids, the kind who still smoke cigarettes and make no effort to do well in school. Ferociously loyal to a counter-school ethic, burnouts are self-marginalizing: by refusing to take academics seriously—or even school-based athletics for that matter—they take themselves out of the running for futures linked to school success.

And what horrifies Eckert: their high schools do nothing about it! The schools stand back, she says, and let kids polarize themselves into social classes on the basis of their parents' social class. The results are serious, because the labels "increasingly restrict individual choices with lasting implications [for] curriculum choice, academic effort, and substance use."

But burnouts are not the only marginalized youth in this country.

Clearly, none of these young people are reaching their potential. What things could schools do—or have done—to prevent such waste?

Eckert suggests that schools could hold the loyalties of burnouts better if they organized courses the way burnouts like them—in ways that encourage collaborative learning. The burnouts she studied in a Detroit suburb hated ordinary academic classes, but they would take art, she observed, because they could interact with classmates and receive individual task-oriented attention from the teacher.

Now the public schools are in bad enough shape. Many do not learn about multiplication until they get to Sex Ed. But federal controls would do something even more messy:

A study from Australia says, "The quality and content of 'education' in our public schools has suffered because the goals of top educators have changed. The present goal is to condition young minds...."

We read of the Nazis in our history books. Why did we not learn the lessons of history?

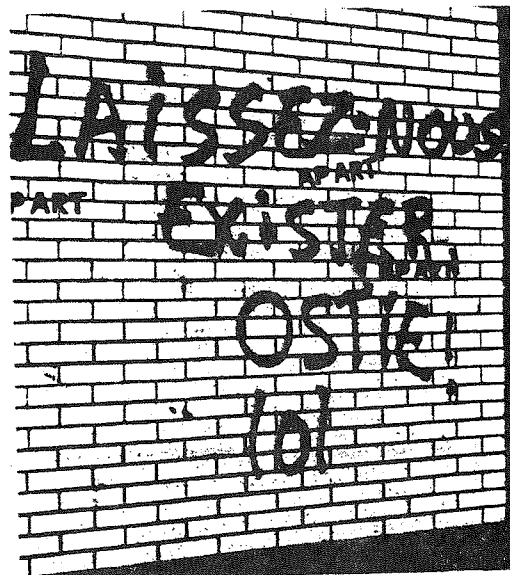

Interpol in St. Cloud, France and the government of New Zealand were the two most helpful. Surprisingly, the director of the South African Department of Justice has sent me the last two annual Verslag reports containing their statistics.

It should be shocking and embarrassing to every real American to learn the U.S. now has the highest relative penal inmate population. This situation has developed very suddenly.

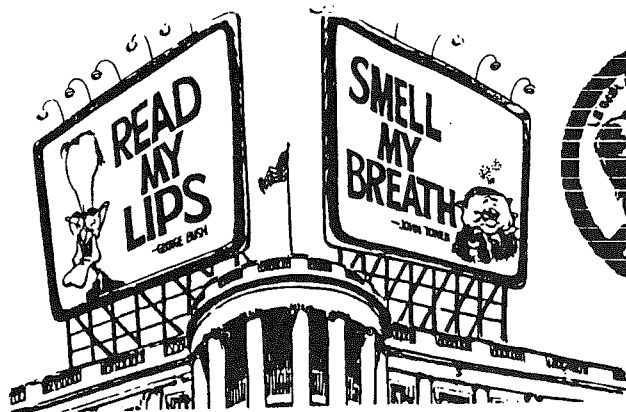
