Libertarian Party of Virginia Eighth Congressional District Bylaws Adopted at Eighth Congressional District Convention March 9, 2002 Amended at Eighth Congressional District Convention November 19, 2005

- 1 The purpose of the 8th Congressional District Committee (8th CDC) shall be:
 - -To further the development of the Libertarian Party of Virginia (LPVA) within the 8th Congressional District.
 - -To nominate Congressional Candidates.
- 2. The 8th CD Executive Committee (EC) shall consist of the following:
 - -A Chairman.
 - -AVice-Chairman.
 - -Three at large-members.
- 3. The 8th CDC will hold District conventions whenever required to nominate Congressional Candidates and to elect the EC, or when called by a majority of the EC. EC members will be elected by majority vote at conventions of the Committee that take place in even-numbered years. Except when filling a vacancy, the term of an officer will last from the end of the convention at which the officer is elected until the end of the convention two years hence.
- 4. An EC member may be elected by majority vote at a meeting of the EC to fill a vacant office. The term of an EC member elected to fill a vacant office will be from the conclusion of that election until the end of the term of the office for which the vacancy is being filled.
- 5. The Chairman of the EC will preside at all meetings of the EC, will serve as the spokesman for the CDC, and will represent the 8th CDC at meetings of the State Central Committee (SCC). Should the Chairman be unable to attend an SCC meeting, the Vice-Chairman shall represent the 8th CDC at the meeting. Should neither the Chairman nor the Vice-Chairman be able to attend an SCC meeting, the Chairman may designate a proxy holder to represent the 8th CDC at the meeting.
- 6. The Vice-Chairman will assume the duties of the Chairman in his absence. Should the Chairman resign or relocate outside of the district, the Vice Chairman shall immediately assume the office of Chairman, and shall call a District convention within ninety (90) days.
- 7. The EC will meet as needed to accomplish the CDC's objectives. The Chairman or a majority of the EC will call the meeting.
- 8. The EC may make appointments as needed to accomplish the committee's objectives.
- 9. The 8th CDC shall be subject to the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Constitution and Bylaws of LPVA, and the current, SCC-approved version of Robert's Rules of Order.
