Liberty Summer Conferences and Camps

Libertarians might find some lively summer fun teaching English, economics, psychology, entrepreneurship, or other specialties at conferences and camps in Eastern Europe. My family has participated in these events for several years, most recently for two weeks with more than a hundred university students and faculty from Belarus at the summer resort of Trakai, Lithuania.

My wife, Li, gave talks about life in China during the Cultural Revolution. My daughter, Kenli, spoke on various economics topics concerning “public goods.” I delivered presentations about the current monetary crisis, immigration, and challenges to income redistribution.

Other speakers filled out the program, including the young libertarians, professors, former executives of the Lithuanian Free Market Institute, who have just been appointed as Minister of Justice and Minister of Education in Lithuania. Some countries of Eastern Europe are leaving American market reforms in the dust!

In addition to presentations, small group discussions, and debates throughout the day, the atmosphere is that of a summer camp with volleyball, lake swimming, music and dancing in the evenings, yoga in the morning, opera at the Trakai Castle, a swamp hike, a trip to the Stalin World (a memorial to the horrors of communism), and even great food.

These events are organized by the International Society for Individual Liberty, the Lithuanian Free Market Institute, the Mises Center of Minsk, and the Language of Liberty Institute. Other camps have been held this summer in Poland, Slovakia, and the Republic of Georgia. Last year we attended the camp in Georgia one week before the Russian invasion. So it can be exciting.

Li is interested in organizing one of these conference/camps in China next year. If any of this interests you, please contact us for details. Aloha!

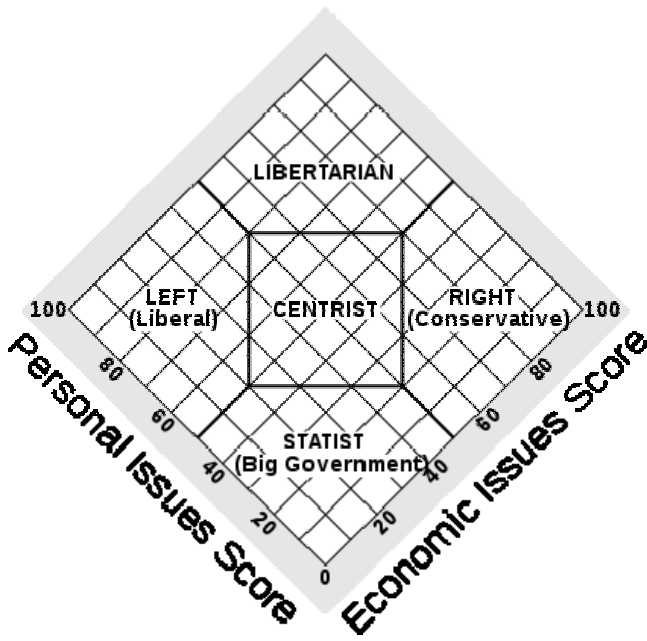
