The Free Libertarian Party endorsed Bob Flanzer as its candidate for New York State Comptroller, at its annual State Convention in Manhattan - March 29-31.

Dr. Flanzer became active in politics during the Libertarian's "Youngstein for Mayor" campaign in 1973. He stated that he "...decided to enter the political arena to offer the voters the choice of 'Laissez-Faire' in opposition to what is now a bleak political landscape".

Dr. Flanzer seeks a free market economy with more protection of individual rights. He became interested in the Free Market approach to solving political problems while studying Ayn Rand's philosophy of Objectivism at the Nathaniel Branden Institute in New York.

Dr. Flanzer, 39 years old, is a practising dentist in Brooklyn's Manhattan Beach area, and a former captain in the Strategic Air Command. He has also attended Brooklyn Law School.
