MEETING SUMMARY April 15, 2020

Date and Time: Wednesday, 15 April 2020 at 4:00pm Mountain time

The meeting was called to order at 4:10pm Mountain time.

Records of Past Meetings: The minutes of the 1 April meeting were approved.

Records Archive: Caryn Ann reported that she has not been able to maintain her regular pattern of off-site backups, which include some items not yet uploaded to LPedia, because she can't access her safe deposit box, but she might be able to store a backup at the storage unit if she had another drive. It was noted that we still have a copy of everything that has already been uploaded to the site on the backup server, plus one committee member has a copy at his home.

Categories: Caryn Ann reported that she is still actively working on this, and suggested that people follow the update log to see what's happening.

General LPedia: Caryn Ann said she had received a report that somebody was making updates regarding Texas that are "all wrong", and suggested that James look into this.

Site Statistics: Ed reported that traffic has been somewhat higher, about 132 users per day, with significant interest in the topic of "libertarian socialism"; it is likely that this is the result of an article having appeared somewhere.

URL Format Change: Ed reported that he is getting ready to submit the request to the hosting company.

Featured Article: Caryn Ann reported that she will be beefing up the article about the February 2020 LNC meeting, including adding a picture.



Committee Membership: Caryn Ann reported that Francis Wendt, an LNC Regional Alternate, may be interested in joining the committee.

Scanning Job: Caryn Ann reported that the company has provided us with the results, but the files will need to be sorted out for further processing; she will share the link with Joe so he can help with that.

Other Scanning: Caryn Ann reported that she had been able to get her large-format flatbed scanner, a "ScanMaker 9800XL" which she had purchased on Ebay a while back, to work after figuring out that there was a shipping screw that needed to be removed; she has Mac software that works with this device. She was also able to pick up a used ordinary scanner for \$8 at Goodwill.

Volunteers: Caryn Ann noted that 'Vermont' will be working on historical e-mails.

National Convention: The situation is still very unclear. Caryn Ann noted that even if there is no convention in May it is possible there will be one in July or August.
