#### Motion(s) Summary

-The Chair opens the floor at 7:12pm for amendments and discussion on the new un amended language about corporations, this is carry over from the previous meeting. A few amendments arose from discussion. The text was amended and moved to be appended to plank 2.8.

Fast moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

Corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. Individuals who form corporations neither gain, nor lose any right they had previous to incorporation and are liable for their acts of willful negligence and fraud. We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state.

Fast amendment PASS 9-2-3 at 8:32pm (see vote Tally Ballot 2) return to main motion

Perry moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state.

Perry amendment <u>PASS 11-2-1</u> at 7:28pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 3</u>) return to main motion

Fast moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

Corporate entities are not people, and possess no rights distinct from the individuals within them. We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state.

Chair rules this a move to reconsider and cannot be moved by Fast, who was not on the prevailing side. Perry rises to move on behalf of Fast.

Perry moves to RECONSIDER

Perry moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

Government is the source of monopoly, through its grants of legal privilege to special interests in the economy. We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state.

Perry amendment <u>FAILS 1-12-1</u> at 7:53pm (see vote Tally <u>Ballot 6</u>)return to main motion

Fast moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

Corporations are not people, and have rights distinctly within them. We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state.

The Chair rules motion [OOO]

Fast moves to amend, the new language, if adopted would read:

We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state. We also oppose corporatism dues to its historical ties to facism.

Adopt New Text as Amended PASS 8-6 at 8:03pm (see vote Tally Ballot 7)

[POI] by Knapp, "Is it in order to place text at the end of plank 2.8?"

[POI] Resolution, "Yes, but the original 2.8 text cannot be amended at this time, due to scope of notice" Knapp MOVES TO APPEND text at end of PLANK 2.8 "Marketplace Freedom"

Append Amended Text to 2.8 PASS 10-3-1 at 8:13pm (see vote Tally Ballot 8)

The amended text and placement is adopted and will be assigned ballot PC2020-PC#19, current text:

Libertarians support free markets. We defend the right of individuals to form corporations, cooperatives and other types of entities based on voluntary association. We oppose all forms of government subsidies and bailouts to business, labor, or any other special interest. Government should not compete with private enterprise. We reject government charter of corporations. We call for a separation of business and state.


